

GOSPEL

Jn 15: 1-8

Jesus said to his disciples: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit. You are already pruned because of the word that I spoke to you. Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me will be thrown out like a branch and wither; people will gather them and throw them into a fire and they will be burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you. By this is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples."

New Lisbon Developmental Center *Garden Of Remembrance*



Fr. John P. Wessel Knights of Columbus Council #6530 has been supporting New Lisbon Developmental Center for over 40 years. Each year, the K of C has hosted an annual Christmas Party for residents of New Lisbon at St. Joan of Arc. As many as fifty residents have enjoyed the annual gathering which includes lunch, music and a visit and gift from Santa Clause.



During the COVID pandemic, the annual collections for New Lisbon by the K of C with the generous support of SJA parishioners amounted to over \$15,000 because there were no Christmas parties during that time. In spring of 2022, the K of C contacted the officers of New Lisbon to explore how the accumulated funds could be utilized to benefit the residents. The officers expressed that they would like the funds to establish a Memorial Garden to commemorate the 47 of the 275 residents of New Lisbon that passed away during the pandemic. The New Lisbon officers gave a hand drawn example of how they envisioned the garden may look. The K of C contacted the owner of a local landscape and gardening center. He generated and donated a beautiful, detailed drawing with various floral items of trees, bushes, colorful flower pieces that would bloom throughout the year with mulch, gravel and boulders to accentuate the garden. The garden design proposal was presented to New Lisbon and was received with

great delight.

To ensure the beauty, success and longevity of the garden it was decided it was necessary to install a sprinkler system. A generous benefactor of the K of C heard of the need and donated the cost of the system (\$6,650). The work started in summer of 2022. The New Lisbon maintenance staff invested many hours preparing the site for the garden; removing existing fencing, dismantling cinder block structures, clearing the site for the garden and framing out the and installing the concrete walkways.

The K of C facilitated the garden installation and communicated with the landscape and garden center, sprinkler donor, sprinkler installer, and the maintenance manager at New Lisbon.

After 18 months the *Garden of Remembrance* was named and completed in November 2023. The officers of New Lisbon Developmental Center are very pleased with the outcome of the project and are looking forward to having a dedication ceremony for the Garden of Remembrance this spring.

The K of C Council #6530 was honored to be part of the New Lisbon Developmental Center *Garden of Remembrance* vision, design, facilitation and construction. The total cost of the site development and completion is estimated to be over \$35,000. Knights of Columbus #6530 council will continue to support the needs of the New Lisbon Developmental Center and the annual Christmas Party for the residents.

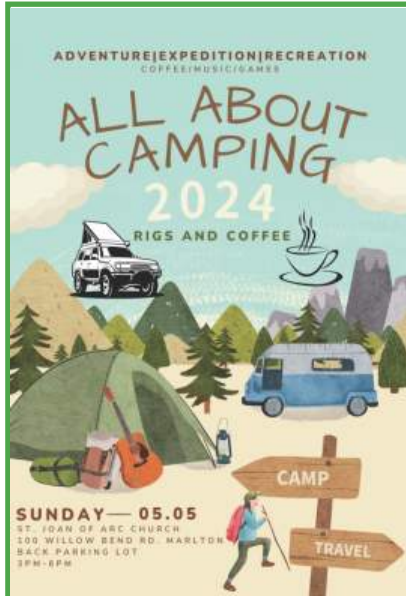

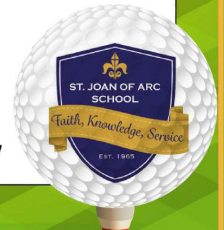
