GOSPEL

Jn 15: 9-17

Jesus said to his disciples: "As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love.

"I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy might be complete. This is my commandment: love one another as I love you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are my friends if you do what I command you. I no longer call you slaves, because a slave does not know what his master is doing. I have called you friends, because I have told you everything I have heard from my Father. It was not you who chose me, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name he may give you. This I command you: love one another."

FAITH SHARING QUESTIONS

In today's gospel, Jesus discusses love AND joy. He commands us to love one another. Jesus' love of all people is the only kind of love that brings us joy — a forever-lasting joy of true happiness and peace. Recall a time recently when you experienced the joy of the risen Jesus? What was the occasion? How did you feel when you experienced deep joy as compared to the joy of eating pizza? What simple ways in your daily life do you love others as Jesus commanded us? Reflect on changes needed in your life to love completely as Jesus did - without conditions.

EASTER COMMAND

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We know from the first chapters of the Bible that rebellion is in our blood. There is a side to us that wants to do what we want to do, no matter if we have been cautioned, advised or commanded to do otherwise. We see this rebellious (maybe you would prefer to call it "independent") spirit in children who seem to master the word "no" rather quickly. We see this in teens, too, who defy parents and do things their own way. And, let's be honest, it's also evident in adults of all ages who think we know better.

Some institutions, most notably the military, would not function if commands are not carried out. In sports, we may not call them commandments, but there are definite rules and if everyone does not play by them the game is in serious trouble.

Speaking of commandments, there are, of course, the 10 Big Ones. If you are a believer, a person of faith, these commandments come from God. They are not the 10 Suggestions or 10 Good Ideas. They are commandments and they come from God. If God means something to us, then we would naturally want to obey them.

Are you aware of a "new commandment" given to His disciples by Jesus? The night before He dies, Jesus does indeed give them, and us by extension, a new commandment. It might even be harder than the 10 Big Ones because, I think, it goes beyond mere obedience. It demands a whole new way of looking at people and our relationship with others.

"Love one another as I love you," Jesus says. Jesus **commands**. What do you think about that?

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION Congratulations to our First Communicants! Over the past two weekends, about 160 children from our parish and school have received their First Holy Communion here at St. Joan of Arc. We are very grateful to the catechists, teachers, and aides who have given so generously of their time and talent to help our children prepare for this beautiful Sacrament.

Summer Program catechist openings!

Our Summer Program is a one week, full-day intensive program for children in grades 1st through 8th. We are offering this popular option this year according to the following schedule:

June 24 - June 28, Monday - Friday, 8:30 am - 2:30 pm and July 8 - 12, Monday - Friday 8:30 am - 2:30 pm

During these weeks, our children attend Mass each morning, work with our music teacher to learn music for Mass, work on service projects, take "field trips" to our prayer garden and other places on our campus, and generally spend the week immersed in learning about and living their faith. As we have moved to this full-day intensive option this year, we are looking for catechists who also teach professionally, as the full-day context of the program requires professional classroom management training and experience. As this is a requirement which goes beyond our normal catechist qualifications, and due to the fact that the program runs during the traditional work day, a stipend is also offered for teachers during each of the Summer Program weeks. (Teachers can be currently employed or retired.)

While we are seeking professional teachers for our Summer Program, teachers must primarily be motivated to share their faith with the children they teach, which is the first and most important qualification of a catechist in any context. 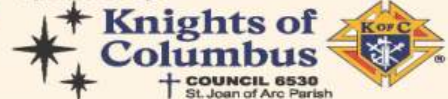
