
GOSPEL

Mk 4: 26-34

Jesus said to the crowds: "This is how it is with the kingdom of God; it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how. Of its own accord the land yields fruit, first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in the ear. And when the grain is ripe, he wields the sickle at once, for the harvest has come."

He said, "To what shall we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable can we use for it? It is like a mustard seed that, when it is sown in the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on the earth. But once it is sown, it springs up and becomes the largest of plants and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the sky can dwell in its shade." With many such parables he spoke the word to them as they were able to understand it. Without parables he did not speak to them, but to his own disciples he explained everything in private.

11th Sunday Ordinary Time / 2024 Give Me Crazy

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Last Sunday we saw some of Jesus' relatives scratching their heads, mumbling about how Jesus was "out of his mind." Crazy. This Sunday, we hear Jesus using parables (short stories with a powerful message) to teach about the Kingdom of God — about the presence of God, about how God works in the world.

Reading the parables, of course, is different from hearing them from the very lips of Jesus. Sometimes the way a story is told is as important as the telling. Jesus, of course, is Himself a visible manifestation of the Kingdom of God, the presence of God. In other words, experiencing the presence of Jesus is experiencing the Kingdom of God.

When I hear these two parables — one about seed being sown and mysteriously yielding a great harvest, another about a tiny mustard seed growing to become a huge tree and home to every kind of bird — I can picture Jesus telling them with eyes wide open in joyful wonder and awe. He must be smiling, too, don't you think? He paints a picture of the Kingdom of God that is so reassuring, so peaceful, so gentle, yet confident and strong. God's kingdom is about life, life that grows and expands, nothing will stop it.

If Jesus is crazy, give me crazy.




