

Dear Parishioners and Friends,


Ever have a "thorn in your side"? Thorns are painful and disruptive. But thorns can also be challenging. Thorns make us pay attention and, if we respond positively, they can potentially even make us better.

For example, it was "a thorn in the flesh" that opened St. Paul's eyes and heart to experience God's grace in a new way. (2 Cor. 12:7-10)

Jesus himself was a thorn in the side of a lot of people, including some of those He grew up with who took great offense of Him. (Mark 6:1-6). Like the prophets of old, Jesus upset the people in power so much so that they almost immediately plotted to do away with Him.

What "thorn" dogs you? Don't deny it or ignore it. Acknowledge it. Be willing to be challenged by it. Be willing to have your mind and heart renewed. The Holy Spirit is always prompting us, moving us to a new place, to be a better person, a better disciple, even a better Church. Sometimes it's a thorn that begins the process.


