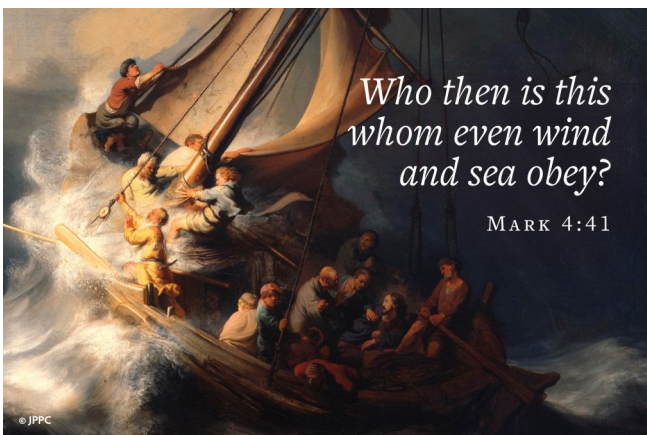

Mk 4: 35-41

On that day, as evening drew on, Jesus said to his disciples: "Let us cross to the other side." Leaving the crowd, they took Jesus with them in the boat just as he was. And other boats were with him. A violent squall came up and waves were breaking over the boat, so that it was already filling up. Jesus was in the stern, asleep on a cushion. They woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" He woke up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Quiet! Be still!" The wind ceased and there was great calm. Then he asked them, "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?" They were filled with great awe and said to one another, "Who then is this whom even wind and sea obey?"

## Out of the Storm

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I love Mark's telling of Jesus and his disciples caught in a storm while crossing the sea. It is a simple, direct telling. No frills. A violent squall comes out of nowhere. The disciples are terrified. They wake Jesus up. He rebukes the wind and while in a bit of a rebuking mood, Jesus rebukes the disciples. "Do you not yet have faith?" The disciples are awe struck.

Me, too.

I'm in awe not so much that Jesus calmed the storm. I'm in awe of the fact that He was sleeping through it. I am more in awe of the fact that the terrified disciples apparently took his sleeping through the storm as indifference to their plight. "Don't you care?" they whine to Jesus. "Don't you care?"

In the previous chapter the disciples had witnessed Jesus healing many people, caring for those enduring the storm of sickness. Now they dare to ask Him, "Don't you care?" I'm in awe that Jesus doesn't trade the lot of them in for a new tribe of disciples the minute they land on shore. (I'm in awe that He hasn't traded *me* in long before now! I've done my own share of whining and sniveling!)

But, no, Jesus doesn't trade the disciples in. Jesus doesn't give up on us the way we too quickly give up on Him. "Don't you care? Where are you? Why won't you help me?"

Instead, Jesus asks the disciples (and us) a question about faith, about trust in Him. "Do you not yet have faith," after all you have witnessed?

If there is one thing we should have learned by now: Jesus *does* care. God *is* with us *and* for us. That's the point of Jesus' birth, life, ministry, death and resurrection. There will be storms. Many of them. Some manageable, some really bad. Maybe we can take a lesson from Him about how a little faith (the size of a mustard seed only), how a little trust in God, can help sail through them.

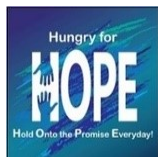

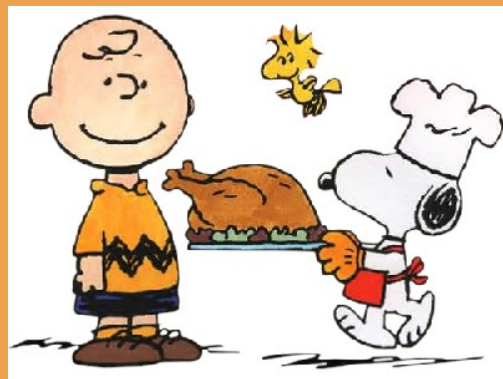
