LOVE IN ACTION: Environmental Tip of the Week



Creation Care Corner



"... we see how environmental deterioration and human and ethical degradation are closely linked" (LS 56). — Pope Francis

ECOLOGICAL SIN

In Pope Francis' encyclical *Laudato Si'*, a holistic understanding of sin is presented. It is the rupture of the basic relationship with the Creator, with our fellow human beings and with creation itself. All of creation is a message of love from God. As such, the destruction of our planetary home is a sin against God. It constitutes nothing less than disrespect towards the Creator. Similarly, it constitutes a sin against our fellow human beings, since a healthy natural environment is for the collective good.

Pollution of land, water or air that harms the health of others is to be considered sinful. In the case of anthropogenic climate change, excessive greenhouse gas emissions which impact poor or vulnerable communities are also considered sinful. If ecological sin is a rupture of fundamental human relationships with the Creator and the rest of creation, then we need to heal that rupture. "It is significant that the harmony which Saint Francis of Assisi experienced with all creatures was seen as healing that rupture" (LS 66).

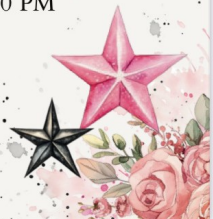
