


GOSPEL Mk 6:7-13

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Every spiritual blessing. Not some. Not one or two. Not a few. Not even many. But, every. "Every spiritual blessing in the heavens." This is what we have been blessed with in Christ Jesus according to the Letter to the Ephesians (1:3).

Furthermore: through Christ, God has "lavished upon us" the "riches of His grace" (Eph. 1:7). Lavish means "generous and extravagant." So, we are not talking about a sprinkling of the riches of God's grace. Not a drizzling of grace. Not even a showering. No, instead, a monsoon! A monsoon of forgiveness and redemption through Christ.

This is God's plan, according to Ephesians. This is what God's will is. This is what God wants for us.

When Jesus sends His disciples out on their mission (our Gospel this Sunday, Mark 6:7-13), this is what He is sending them out with. Let's not sell God short. Let's not limit God's abundant grace. Let's not curtail or confine the mercy of God. Let's not restrict God's divine plan of redemption.

Let's believe what God wants for us and gives to us. Let's celebrate it! Let's proclaim it from the rooftops! Let's share it with everyone ... no exceptions!


