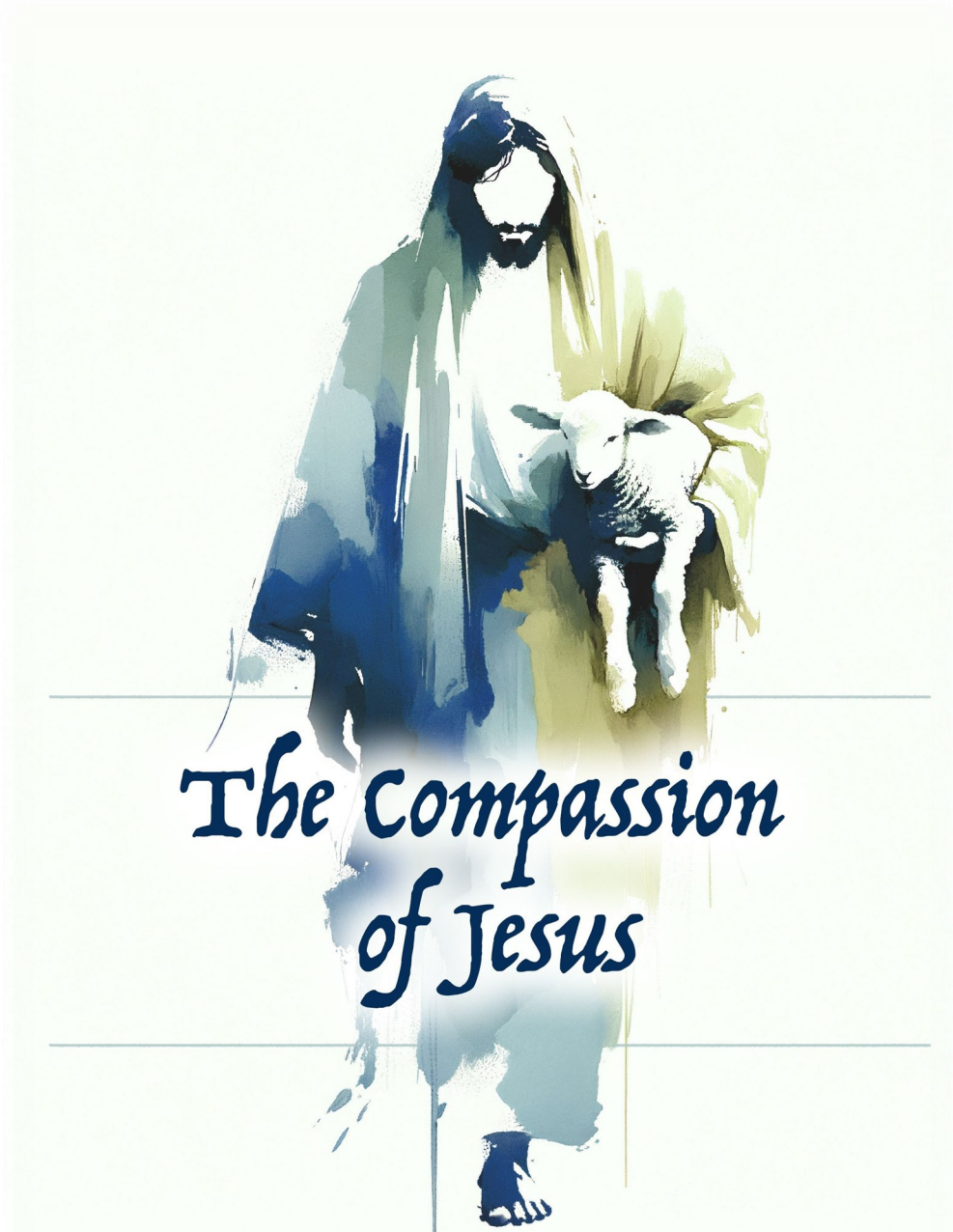

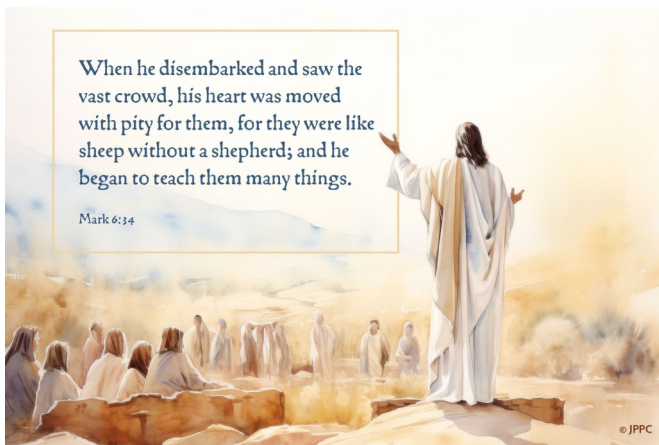
GOSPEL

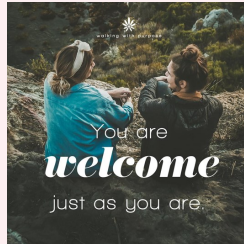

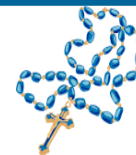

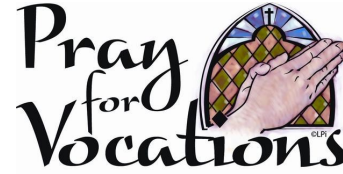
