

### Help Those in Need Get Their Taxes Done For Free

Each year AARP volunteers offer free assistance to low and middle-income

taxpayers in the preparation of their federal and state tax returns. Sites usually are open one day a week, from February 1<sup>st</sup> until April 15<sup>th</sup>. Clients and volunteers do not have to be members of AARP or a senior to participate in this program.

In order to keep the program going we need volunteers willing to work as Tax Counselors and Client Facilitators. All returns are done on AARP provided Chromebook computers and electronically filed. Tax Counselors should be comfortable using a computer and willing to learn how to prepare non-complex returns. Client Facilitators should be comfortable welcoming clients and assisting them checking in. New Tax Counselors will receive four days training in early December, another three days training in January and ample resources to ready them for tax preparation.
