WHERE IS THE MOUNTAIN?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Mountains are important in the Bible. Mentioned no less than 500 times, mountains are often depicted as the meeting place between God and human beings. Think of Mt. Sinai where the 10 Commandments are received by Moses; think of Mt. Tabor where Jesus is transfigured before the apostles Peter, James and John.

So, it will feel a little strange when in today's Gospel passage from Luke (6:17,20-26) we hear of Jesus “coming down” from a mountain where he has just been praying. It is then on “a level stretch of ground,” Jesus begins teaching not only to “a great crowd of his disciples” but also to “a large amount of people.” This is the great Sermon on the Plain.

What? Sermon on *the Plain*? Yup. No mountain in Luke. (If you want the Sermon on the Mount look up Matthew 5-7). In a way, this is actually good timing for those of us coming down the mountain of victory last Sunday! So, what's going on here?

I know St. Luke is known as a physician, but I like to think of him as Luke the Geographer. Geography is really important to him and he purposely places Jesus' most important Sermon on flat ground, open space. Luke wants us to know that this Sermon is for all of us, all people and that all of us, all people, have access to Jesus. Furthermore, I think Luke wants us to know when we live the Beatitudes and the rest of Jesus' teachings, there will be no barriers, no walls, no divisions between people. We will all live in peace and harmony as children of God — as God intended from the beginning. How blessed we will be to live this way; but woe to us if we choose to live otherwise.

Let's show the world
that it can be done.

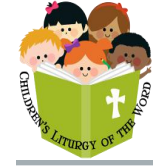

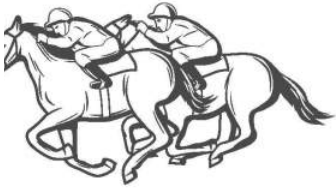
