

## Third Sunday in Lent 2025

### HERE'S A QUESTION

Dear Pilgrims,

I want to thank Fr. Simeon Gallagher for a terrific Parish Mission last week. I am so grateful, also, to the Adult Faith Enrichment Team who sponsored the Mission and also to the many parishioners and friends who came out last week. I found Fr. Simeon's words on the Eucharist as very affirming of all we have talked about these past three years during the Eucharistic Revival. He is a great speaker and truly has left his mark on many of us.

In particular, I was deeply touched by Father Simeon's homily last Sunday in which he talked about the importance of asking the right questions. Too many of us don't, he said, and we therefore find ourselves spinning around and around and going nowhere. For example, one wrong question is: "Why did God do this to me?" Better to ask, Fr. Simeon said, "What is God teaching me?"

I think the Sunday Scriptures this week are a good follow-up to this discussion. Implied in our Scriptures this week is the question: "Is God for us or against us?" If you answer, "for us," another good question to consider is: "do I pray as if God is for me? When I talk about God to others, do I speak as if God is for us?" Think about it.





## LOVE IN ACTION: Life, Justice, and Creation



During Lent, as we pray, fast and give alms, it is good to reflect on what our Church teaches about Social Justice. *Many Catholics are not aware of the 7 themes of Catholic Social Teaching.* Below is a brief breakdown of each theme:

- 1. LIFE AND DIGNITY OF THE HUMAN PERSON:** The Catholic Church proclaims that human life is sacred and that the dignity of the human person is the foundation of a moral vision for society. Abortion, the death penalty, cloning and euthanasia all threaten the value of human life.
- 2. CALL TO FAMILY & COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION:** How society is organized—in economics, law, politics and policy—directly affects human dignity and growth in communities. Marriage and family are central to our social institutions. People have a right and a duty to participate in society, and to work for the common good, especially for the poor and vulnerable.
- 3. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:** Human rights must be protected. Every person has a right to life and human decency.
- 4. OPTION FOR THE POOR AND VULNERABLE:** A basic moral test of society is how our most vulnerable members are treated. Christ commands us to put the needs of the poor and vulnerable first (Mt 25: 31-46).
- 5. DIGNITY OF WORK AND RIGHTS OF WORKERS:** The economy must serve people, not the other way around. Work is participation in God's creation. The basic rights of workers need to be respected-- the right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to the organization and joining of unions, to private property, and to economic initiative.
- 6. SOLIDARITY:** We are one human family regardless of race, nationality, ethnicity or ideological differences. Loving our neighbor as Christ commanded has global dimensions. At the core of the virtue of solidarity is the pursuit of justice and peace.
- 7. CARE FOR GOD'S CREATION:** We show our respect for our Creator by taking care of His creation. Care for the earth is a requirement of our faith. We are called to protect people and the planet, and live in harmony with all of God's creation. This environmental challenge has fundamental moral and ethical dimensions that cannot be ignored.




